

HELPFUL HINTS FOR HOME LESSON SUCCESS

- Each family should have 1 (one) home lesson booklet per child.
- Each lesson should be done with at least one of the parents. Please see the schedule handed out from the Parent Meeting.
- The lesson should take about 15 minutes to accomplish. All you need to do is to read through the lesson with your child and do the activities contained in each chapter. The review pages will also need to be done. **You will want to read through each lesson ahead of time in order to make the best use of your special time together.**
- You may want to set a place in your home where you will meet each week to do the lessons (the kitchen table or living room). Finding a consistent place to meet helps children remember that what you are working on is special and sacred. You could place a candle and Bible in this place to remind you and your child that this is not just normal everyday homework but that you are learning about God which is special and different, something sacred and holy. He is always present with us as we encounter Him in our lessons. As you light the candle you can say, "Jesus said, I am the Light of the world".
- No worries if younger or older siblings decide to sit down and listen along with you. It can be a great recollection and reinforcement for the entire family.
